Reading Luke's Gospel Parables for Prayer and Proclamation. The parables of Luke's Gospel provide some of the most inspiring narratives and characters of the Christian Scriptures—the Good Samaritan, the Prodigal Son, the Rich Man and Lazarus. These parables are also hugely insightful into the nature of human life, of the Church, and even into the nature and character of Jesus' God. Following the discipline of Lectio Divina, Father Séamus O'Connell (Professor of Scripture at St Patrick's College, Maynooth), will guide participants in the discovery of new life in these texts we think we know. In our lectio, the Lord shows us how he wants to stay in our house each day (see Luke 19:5). Our reading and reflection leads to prayer, praise, thanksgiving, and wonder. The Lord calls us to turn again, to follow him anew, and to tell what has happened to us on the way (see Luke 24:35).
